Sat. 28th July - For novice/intermediate players & rusty returners! (Approx. Grade 1-5)

Sun. 29th July - For more confident or advanced players. (Approx. Grade 5-Diploma)

** Intermediate players are encouraged to attend both days of the workshops.*

**Advanced players are welcome to join us on both days, to support the novices, and enjoy a fully immersive flute weekend!*

Novice: a player between the grades of 1 and 3.

Grade 1: low D to C in the second octave.
